The Voices of Tufts Diversity Experiences - Counselor Instructions

Dear Counselor,

Your student has submitted an application for the Voices of Tufts Diversity Experiences, two overnight visit programs for high school seniors to learn more about the academic and social offerings at Tufts University. **The Engineering Experience will take place on October 19-20, 2017 and the Arts & Sciences Experience will take place on October 26-27, 2017.** The invited students will be housed with a current undergraduate on campus. All meals will be provided, and travel assistance is available for those students for whom the trip would be a financial hardship.

In order to complete this student's application, we ask you to submit the following materials:

- A current academic transcript, including the student's senior year courses
- A letter of recommendation indicating why this student would be a good candidate to attend Voices and Tufts University

Please note that in order for students to be considered for the **Engineering Experience**, applications and all required materials must be received by **5:00 PM EST on October 3, 2017**. For the **Arts & Sciences Experience**, applications and all required materials must be received by **5:00 PM EST on October 11, 2017**, however priority for travel assistance funding will be given to applications completed by **October 4, 2017**. Due to the volume of applications we receive, we are not able to consider incomplete applications and those received after the deadline.
